Checklist for your income tax return



<u>In the first year</u>

- Tax assessment from the previous year
- Tax declaration from the previous year, if available
- Tax identification number of person required to pay taxes/spouse/children

Special expenses

- o Donation receipt
- Base pension/Rürup statement
- Contributions to pension fund
- Health insurance
 - Proof of base rate (for voluntarily / privately insured persons)
 - Reimbursement of contributions (e.g. bonus programme)
- Contributions to Riester pension scheme
- Other insurance contributions (e.g. life, liability, vehicle, accident insurance)
- ! Other insurance contributions only deductible to a limited extent

Extraordinary expenses

- Illness-related costs (e.g. medications, dentist, etc.)
- Proof of disability
 - o Handicapped ID
 - Pension fund statement
 - Pension assessment concerning accident benefit
- Proof of care degree
- Do you care for relatives in need of care?
- Child support/parent support/alimony payments
- Health insurance payments for sustentative persons

Household-related services and repairs/renovations

- Costs for janitorial work, snow removal, garden maintenance, cleaning services, au-pair
- Annual statement of homeowners' association
- Maintenance, painting, flooring work
- o Repairs
- ! Separate disclosure of labour expenses necessary
- ! Bank account statement (no cash payment)

<u>Children</u>

- Child benefits received
- Relation to further persons (complete address of other parent)
- Childcare costs, e.g. kindergarten, childminder, au-pair.
- o School fees
- o Health insurance contributions
- Over 18 years of age:
 - $\circ \quad \text{Training or apprenticeship contract}$
 - o Certificate of enrolment
 - $\circ~$ Bafög (student grant) notice
 - $\circ \quad \text{Certificate of wage tax deduction}$
 - o Address in case of nonresidence

Income from salaried employment

- Certificate of wage tax deduction
- Certificate of unemployment benefit, parental benefits, maternity benefits, etc.
- Certificate of capital-forming investments (e.g. savings contract with a building society): Annex VL

Income from pension drawn

 - Property funds
 - Joint ownership of real estate with rental income

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
